AUSTRIAN SKI/SNOW BOARD TRIP

The Department of Physical Education is offering pupils the chance to participate in a trip to Zell am See, Austria, during Activities Week 2005.

Although this week is primarily based around skiing and snow boarding, pupils will be involved in a wide range of other activities such as bowling, football, a treasure hunt, and shopping.

It is intended that four members of staff will accompany no more than 25 pupils. This provides an excellent teacher – pupil ratio of 1:6.

The trip will cost **£399**. For this pupils will receive luxury coach travel to and from Austria, full board accommodation, five days ski/board hire and instruction, a five day lift pass, all evening entertainment, full use of the coach when in Austria, comprehensive insurance, and 'group' passport.

Pupils will require only spending money and cash to buy meals en route.

The trip is open to girls and boys and will cost **£335**, maximum. (This price may go down if a large number of pupils sign up for the trip.) This includes everything except spending money.

PARIS TRIP

Pupils will also enjoy an evening boat trip on the river Seine and a full day at Walt Disney Studios/Disneyland.

The trip is organised by NST, a nationally accredited travel company with full ABTA credentials. Transport is by coach and ferry and we will be staying at the FIAP Jean Monnet, an international conference centre located in the very centre of Paris.

The trip will cost **£350**. This price is inclusive of transport, accommodation, and entry to all attractions. Pupils will only require spending money.
